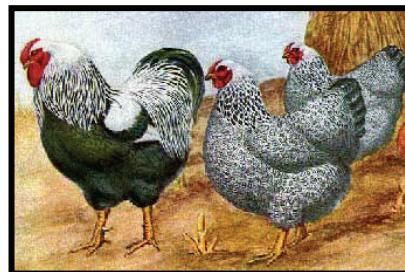

5. All entries must be penned by 8.30 am Saturday.
6. Judging will commence at 9.00am Saturday.
7. ENTRIES \$2.00 per bird for members of the Wyandotte Club of Australia.
8. **NON – MEMBER’S of the WCA Inc are NOT ELIGIBLE for competition at this event.**
9. Entries must be in duplicate (and Readable).
10. Team entries, Breeding pairs and CB & PB entries are ineligible for MAJOR AWARDS.

## JUNIOR SHOW AND SHOWMANSHIP JUDGING

MR. TOM BOWDEN SA

This is a new approach to the showing of Junior entries in a bid to stop an adult from entering a bird in a junior's name and the Junior has little or no interest in the Wyandotte apart from winning with a bird they have had no contact with on a daily basis  
This is based on the American system that seems to work very well there.

The concept is that the Junior pens his or her own entries.

During the process of judging, the exhibitors are present for them to be interviewed by the judge on the bird that they have entered. The entrant would or should be able to answer the Judge about the good and bad points of the bird if asked.

The eventual winner is decided by the quality of the bird they have entered and their ability to tell the judge the merits of that entry.

All exhibitors must be under 16 years old.

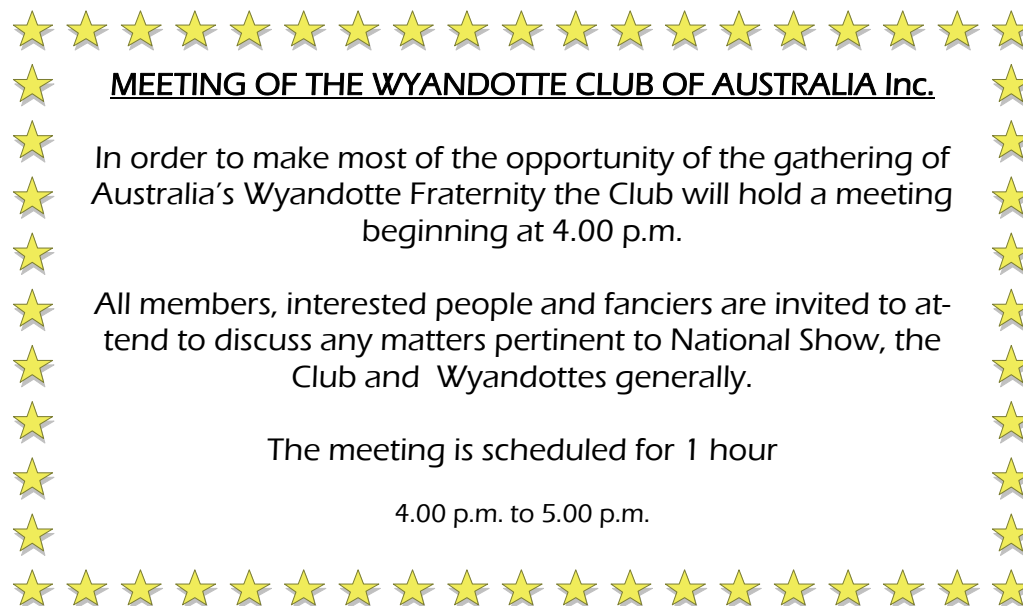
